

Supplies:

- St. Erasmus coloring page
- Globe and name plate template
- Colored pencils or crayons
- Clear plastic dessert plate (6")
- Glue stick
- Yellow and blue puffy paint (or window cling gel pens)
- Clear tape



Instructions:

- Color the St. Erasmus, the ship and waves, and the base of the globe template.
- Cut out St. Erasmus and the ship in a close outline (it doesn't have to be perfect)
- Write "St. Erasmus, Pray for Us." On the name plate.
- 4. Cut out the globe template and name plate from the globe template sheet.
- Glue the ship and St. Erasmus to the globe template. Hint: Leave room on the bow of the ship to glue St. Erasmus into the ship.
- On the clear plastic plate, make
 lightning and raindrops on the face
 of the plate using the yellow and blue
 puffy paint (or gel pens).
- 7. Allow the paint to dry for a couple minutes then flip the plate over on top of the globe. Hint: the paint can continue to dry after the project is complete.
- 8. Tape the plate to the globe.
- Tape or glue the name plate to the base of your storm globe.
