St. Charles de Foucauld Little Brothers of Jesus Tunic

Supplies:

36"x36" piece of white felt (cut into thirds)
Red yarn
St. Charles de Foucauld template (printed on card stock)
White school glue
Hot glue gun

Directions:

- 1. Cut out the heart and cross insignia from the template.
- 2. Cut 70-75 pieces of yarn, each between 3-4" long.
- 3. Starting at the top of the cross, use school glue to cover the template with the pieces of yarn placed horizontally (the strips of yarn should hang off the template.)
- 4. Let it dry, then flip over the template and cut off the excess yarn.
- 5. Fold the piece of felt in half, place a 5-6" diameter bowl halfway over the fold, and trace the half circle on the front.
- 6. Cut the folded cloth along the traced line to make a circle.
- 7. Use the hot glue gun to secure the heart and cross on the front of the tunic, in the center, about 2" below the neckline.
- 8. Place the tunic on your child's shoulders and talk about how St. Charles de Foucauld wanted nothing more than to live the life of Jesus whom he loved above all.
